

How To Prepare Your Song For The Mix Service:

In order to provide you with the highest quality mix for your project, we ask that you follow these simple guidelines...

All projects:

1. Please have your song's tracks split up into their own individual audio files.
2. Each file should be in **WAV format** with **24 bit depth** at **48 kHz sample rate**. If they are different, please let us know what the properties of your files are.
3. Please label each file in accordance to the track it represents. Example: Bass, Electric GTR 1, Background Vocals, etc.
4. Each file should start at the same point (even if there is silence). This will ensure that they all start at the appropriate time.
5. Remove/bypass any reverb or delay effects.

Tips for Pro Tools Users:

1. Remove/bypass any reverb or delay effects.
2. Highlight all of your regions/clips in the edit window. You can drag all of them, or simply **option + click** the name tag of any track and then press **⌘ A**.
3. Once highlighted, press **⌘ shift K**. Select WAV, Multiple Mono, 24 bit, 48 kHz, then choose your output directory. Click **Export...**

Tips for Logic Pro Users:

1. Remove/bypass any reverb or delay effects.
2. Enable Cycle Mode by pressing the button on the Transport Bar. Highlight the length of the song at the top of the Arrange Window (should be a solid green bar).
3. Go to File --> Export --> All Tracks as Audio Files, or press **⌘ shift E**.
4. Choose WAV, 24 bit. Click **Save**.
